

## STATE AND PROVINCIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE/REGISTRATION

The NPLEX are international examinations and you are expected to have the general knowledge required to practice in all jurisdictions within the US and Canada. This may mean that you are required to have knowledge over and above the scope of practice in any particular jurisdiction. In jurisdictions that regulate the licensure/registration of naturopathic physicians/doctors (with the exception of Ontario), you are required to pass both the Part I - Biomedical Science (BSE) and the Part II - **Core** Clinical Science Examination (CCSE). In addition, to be eligible for licensure in some jurisdictions, you may be required to also pass NPLEX Part II - Clinical **Elective** Examinations in Acupuncture (AEE), Elective Pharmacology (EPE), Minor Surgery (MSE), and/or Parenteral Medicine Elective (PMEE). State and provincial requirements are subject to change. NABNE cannot guarantee that the information below is accurate. You should check with the regulatory authority in the jurisdiction in which you plan to practice regarding jurisdiction-specific policies and to confirm which NPLEX examinations are required for eligibility to become licensed/registered as a naturopathic physician/doctor.
